
Student and Parent / Carer Surveys Summer 2024









Across all surveys, responses were generally more positive compared to the Autumn survey, which is pleasing given the fact that in previous years, this has not been the case, perhaps suggesting that initial enthusiasm for many aspects of school life wears off over the course of the year. This is significant as there is normally a general increase in positive responses from the Summer to Autumn Surveys, which often reflects a return to the levels of the previous Autumn (i.e. there is no real overall year-on-year positive trend); hopefully the in-year positives demonstrated in the current surveys will translate into further positives in next Autumn's Surveys.

One positive trend identified in responses from both parents/carers and students was in relation to the questions on 'my child doing well' and students being provided with challenging work, with more positive responses being recorded for both compared to the Autumn Survey.

Both staff and students responded with some positivity in relation to bullying – positive responses from staff relating to the school dealing effectively with cases of bullying were up and although students indicated that more of them had experienced bullying, responses relating to reporting this and it being dealt with were more positive. Parents and carers on the other hand were less positive regarding bullying.

Responses relating to student behaviour were mixed across the three cohorts: parent and carer responses were more positive compared to the Autumn Survey, as were staff responses. Student responses regarding behaviour seem to indicate a shift from 'neither agree nor disagree' to more negative views.



STUDENT SURVEY – 986 Responses (1,210 responses in Autumn 2023, 1,047 responses in Summer 2023)

There were fewer responses to the Student Survey compared to previous ones as, due to the later timing of the survey, no Year 11 students were able to provide responses.

Positive responses were up in nine categories, although in most cases, this was only by a small amount. The most significant increase was a 4% higher positive response to the question regarding being given the opportunity to consider careers were up compared to the Autumn Survey but this is a similar pattern to previous years, where students may not have had that opportunity in the first term.

Few questions saw fewer positive responses compared to the Autumn Survey (having an adult to talk to, student behaviour, experiencing bullying or discrimination and recommending the school). In relation to the behaviour question, there seems to have been a shift from positive responses to more neutral ones, rather than a definite increase in negative responses. Although more students indicated that they had experienced bullying or prejudice, responses to the question about whether this had been reported and solved were actually more positive compared to the Autumn.

Student comments on the best thing about HBK were very similar to the Autumn Survey, with the top five responses being exactly the same (mentions of teachers, food, sports, friends and the site/facilities).

Students who had experienced bullying or discrimination and not reported it cited the fact that they have solved the issue themselves or didn't see it as a big deal as the main reasons for not doing so.

The comments relating to recommending the school to a friend were again very similar to the Autumn Survey, with general comments about HBK being a good school, teachers, being the best school in the area, ethos and facilities being the top 5 positive comments and generally negative comments, the behaviour system, student behaviour, teachers and bullying being the most common negative comments made (though far fewer students cited bullying compared to the Autumn Survey).

PARENTS/CARERS SURVEY 216 responses — (335 in Autumn 2023, 242 responses in Summer 2023)

Out of the 13 categories, 6 saw more positive responses compared to the Autumn survey, most notably to the question relating to the school responding to concerns (up 13%). Other increases in positive responses were for questions relating to student behaviour, my child doing well, the school keeping me informed, extra-curricular activities and recommending the school.

Questions that saw fewer positive responses related to bullying, SEND provision, the range of subjects and opportunities for wider Personal Development.

Comments relating to recommending the school saw over twice as many positives compared to negatives. Positive comments were very broadly in line with the previous survey, with the top 5 being made up of generally positive comments, comments stating that their child is happy at the school, is making good progress, staff and ethos. These were the same top 5 as the Autumn Survey. Negative comments related to the behaviour system, communications, a decline in standards, individual needs not being met, and the size of the school. This is almost the same as last time – previously concerns regarding cover lessons and long-term supply were mentioned more often than in the current survey.

The final question giving parents and carers an opportunity to make additional comments saw very similar responses to the 'recommend the school' ones.

In comparison to published figures for Ofsted Parentview (up to April 2024), Hinchingbrooke continues to score more positively overall than nationally. In the past we have tended to have fewer positive results compared to the East of England figure, which includes all education settings, not just secondaries, however the 2023 to 2024 survey results are generally much closer to the East of England figures and, in some cases, are more positive. This suggests that the smaller scale positives taken from parental surveys this year need to be viewed in the wider context of a national and local picture where parental satisfaction is tending to decrease.
